














Staff Spotlight

Remote Irrigation System

VARIABLE SPEED DRIVE & CONTROLLER INSTALL

Middy's customer, Greg Maher contacted Troy Crawford (Middy's Industrial Business Development Manager, Central & Northern Victoria, Riverina & ACT regions) for his industrial automation expertise as he was chasing a solution for a variable speed drive and controller to run an irrigation pump. Greg provided Troy with an outline of his requirements, and Troy then engaged Scope Electrical Solutions' Design Team to work on a custom design to fulfill Greg's brief.

Greg approved the design and the materials were then provided by Middy's Electrical. From there, Scope Electrical created detailed schematic drawings and built the controller. The controller was thoroughly bench tested in the workshop and then shipped to Greg for him to install on-site with detailed installation instructions and phone support when required.

Greg required the controller to be user friendly. He also required a remote control with mobile phone alerts, flow failure feedback, variable speed drive status feedback, scheduler for set and stop start times on hours and days of the week, the ability to run at a set pressure, adjustable set point and finally a fault history time and date stamped.

The team installed an Allen Bradley M820 Micro-PLC, Allen Bradley components including a HMI 7" Colour Touch Screen, an ABB ACQ Aqua Variable Speed Drive and PDS SMS – 4 EZY Switch SMS Messenger.

Greg's customer can now turn the irrigation pump on and off from anywhere on the farm with his mobile phone and the pump can also send text message notifications if it has faulted, or when the pump is stopped and started on-site. The customer can also set a desired pressure and the pump will adjust its speed to achieve the set point. The controller can be set in three states, the first being Auto (the pump will run on set times in the scheduler) second, remotely (the pump will start and stop when sent messages via an app) and lastly, manually (the pump will start and stop from touch screen located on the controller on site).

State Of The Art Composting Technology



Camperdown Compost Company (CCC) has been selling compost since 1998. Starting from humble beginnings as a worm farm, they are currently hoping to manage an increase of up to 50,000 tonnes of waste a year. They are one of very few companies to be a licensed Environment Protection Authority (EPA) site in this field.

Liquid waste from the local dairy plants and solid organic matter is processed by biological drying through an aerated static pile composting process to pasteurise the waste, followed by an open turned windrow process to compost and mature the product.

CCC is the leading supplier of on-farm composting solutions in Victoria's Western District. With the desire to increase production, they ventured as far as Austria to source state of the art composting technology. An Australian first. CCC then needed to improve their site infrastructure to support this new technology.

They turned to Scott Narik and his team at Kiran Maintenance Services from Camperdown to deliver the electrical components of the installation. Being a design and construct project, Scott in turn, enlisted the services of Hank Terpstra from the Middy's Industrial team to help assist him with the project.

With his expertise, Hank was able to bring his knowledge and experience to the job. Hank sourced a free-standing CT metered main switchboard form 2bi 30ka along with 2 x NHP IP66 400amp free standing custom distribution boards to complete the project.

Having used Hank on previous jobs, I had the confidence that it would get done right and that the right choice of manufacturer would be selected for our specific site needs. Veterinarian Alkaline Hydrolysis

PET CREMATION MACHINE INSTALL

Warren and Leanne Martin purchased a Veterinarian Alkaline Hydrolysis machine (PET-550) which is a pet cremation machine from Bio Response Solutions in America. This is the first in Victoria and the second in Australia to use this technology compared to the traditional gas fired way.

The machine runs at 92 degrees for 18 hours in 700 litres of water. This process is 90% more efficient than the alternative gas fired option.

Warren and Leanne reached out to Gary Askew (Owner of Leahys Electrical) to help with the installation process.

The machine wiring was originally supposed to be supplied in compliance with Australian wiring standards before being shipped to Australia, however that was not to be the case. Gary spent two weeks attempting to source a solution but struggled to get one. He then enlisted the help of the Middy's Industrial team to resolve the issue.

Upon inspection, Hank Terpstra from Middy's Industrial recognised that the machine hadn't been configured correctly. After liaising with BRS Hank and the team managed to provide a custom solution consisting of a 3 phase transformer 415V/220V at 26KVA, which was built locally in just two days.


