2022 Training Scholarship Program


Pink Tradie Campaign


What are your hobbies?

Twin-sheet vacuum-formed manufactures

SAFETY CONTROL BOARD BUILD

Transformed Plastix is Australia's Industry leader in Twin Sheet Vacuum Forming technology. This flexible and innovative company was established in 1999 and is the only company within Australia capable of manufacturing large format twin-sheet vacuum-formed components.

Ben Beel, owner of Beel Electrical based in Dromana, was challenged with the task of design and construct of both the Electrical motor control as well as how to source a solution for the safety systems. As this was a patent design and custom build fit for purpose project, we were challenged with designing a system that was not only safe and compliant but also did not hinder the operator of the equipment. With assistance from Dean Sullivan, Middy's Industrial BDM, we came up with a solution using an Allen Bradley Safety Zone Laser Scanner. This was designed and constructed by Kieran East from Beel Electrical with the custom-made safety control board built and wired into a floor housing. The scanner enabled the user to select between three configurations that ensured safe operation when it came to all configurations of the machine.

From Albert Park to Darwin, let's take a look at the recent races of the 2022 Repco Supercars Series...



Melbourne 400 at the Formula One Australian GP, Albert Park

"Wrong time, wrong moments" at the Melbourne 400, Formula One Australian Grand Prix.

Bryce Fullwood put it best for the team after the first day on track for the Melbourne 400 at the Formula One Australian Grand Prix.



The new layout is super-fast and really awesome to drive. The time sheet was all over the place all day with people trying to learn the new circuit but we're all really looking forward to going racing.

Practice was a mixed bag with the team coming to grips with car set up on the new look circuit. Practice one saw Middy's Racing's Bryce in 10th and Practice two saw him pushed further down the field to 11th.

The first qualifying session was red-flagged early after a heavy crash involving Jake Kostecki at Turn 5. Unfortunately, Bryce had yet to hit flying laps and posted times to position himself in P19. Race 7 qualifying ran the full course with him coming in 17th.

On day 2 qualifying, the field was almost perfectly split in terms of tyre strategy for the opening 20-lap race, with 13 cars starting

on the soft tyre and 12 on the hard. Bryce started on softs, but it was quickly evident the softer compound was wearing fast on the freshly resurfaced Albert Park track. Even so, the Middy's Racing pink rocket finished a solid 10th.

A scrappy race kicked off proceedings on day 3 for Race 7. Bryce lined up in 17th on the grid and made a good start. The Middy's Racing rocket ran relatively unscathed escaping the chaos of the midfield and went on to finish 12th. The penultimate race of the weekend saw Bryce struggle with grip which caused him to drop down the field. His second race of the day saw him finish 22nd.

With the team in great spirits on day four, unfortunately, some more "wrong time, wrong place" moments, car failures and challenges with pace set the scene for the remainder of the Melbourne 400. Sunday's final race saw Bryce (P21) on the starting grid. He again struggled for pace in the Middy's Racing #14 car, particularly on the hard compound tyres.



Bryce fully focused at the Perth Supernight

Perth... A wild weekend for Supercars' return to the West.

It was the first time the Repco Supercars Championship has made it to Western Australia since 2019 due to border closures and COVID restrictions and for Bryce, 2022 would also be his main series debut at Wanneroo Raceway having previously contesting Super2 at the circuit.

The three-race format weekend opened with the "SuperNight" on Saturday. The knockout three-part qualifying for Race 10 saw Middy's Racing's entry, Bryce Fullwood eliminated after Q1 along with the likes of Chaz Mostert and Lee Holdsworth to line up in P22 on the grid.

Race 10 saw Bryce have an incident-plagued race, with the transaxle in the #14 car failing on lap 32 - recording a DNF.

Sunday morning brought with it back-to-back qualifying sessions for Race 11 and 12: For Race 11 Bryce placed 18th and for Race 12, 21st.

Contact on the last lap of Race 11 between Fullwood and Smith left both cars with punctures while in P20 and P21. Fullwood detoured into Pit Lane missing the opportunity to cross the start/finish line while Smith's car was beached in the sand trap, leaving both to record DNFs.

Race 12 was a solid race for Bryce who took four tyres taking him to P14. A late safety car set the scene for an intense last couple of laps but all BJR cars made it home to round out the Perth SuperNight.

Another character building weekend at Winton.

After finishing 20th, 21st and 23rd in races 13, 14 and 15 respectively at Winton, Bryce opened up about his 2022 struggles admitting he is "nowhere near" his expected benchmark after his early rounds with Brad Jones Racing.

The 2019 Super2 champion has recorded two top 10s in 15 starts, both coming at Albert Park.

"It's been a tough start to the year. But it's been a perfect storm with a new driver and a new engineer. We knew it was going to be hard, but we've struggled more than we expected. A few times, we've gone down a rabbit hole with the car the wrong way. We didn't have enough time to look into the problem; it's generally the week after. Our championship is so competitive and tight, that you don't need to be far off the money to miss out. At Winton, I'd only done a Super2 race there a few years ago. But I'm not using that as an excuse."

Fullwood is 199 points off his 2021 points tally after five rounds. The 24-year-old refused to make excuses for his slow start, but cited two-day race meetings as a major hurdle to his progress.



Once we get it working, the car has potential. Learning with a new engineer is like learning a new language; partnerships are important. Phil Keed, our engineer, is a very smart man; we've been working quite hard behind the scenes to align ourselves more. It's hard at the moment with two-day race meetings; they're not friendly to people trying to work their cars out.


"Across our land, we see various weather patterns that signal the changing of seasons, mainly through the hot and humid summer months," Jedess said.


