What is the e-waste Drop Off Bin?

The e-waste Drop Off Bin serves as a collection point for end-oflife products, allowing for more responsible recycling, thus creating a more sustainable future. The bin can then be opened and collected by a nominated provider at an agreed-upon interval.

An environmentally aware property investor, Brendan Sullivan required a solar solution for his commercial building located on Police Rd, Mulgrave. The building has a ground level car park and two levels on top comprising commercial space divided into 4 tenancies.

Brendan approached Benn Simpson of Green Edge Technologies to come up with a solar solution for his building. Green Edge Technologies is a progressive electrical consulting company with extensive experience in alternative energy supply technologies. Benn proposed a solar PV system to provide power to the tenancies in order to reduce outgoings and minimise greenhouse gas emissions. The project consisted of a total of 100kW of solar panels spread across two electricity meters with a 60kW group and a 40kW group, enabling multiple tenants to receive the solar generated power benefits.

Benn used Middy's EnergyTrust[®] software to present the solution as a clear proposal to the customer enabling a quick and easy decision to proceed. The EnergyTrust[®] software uses customers energy bills and usage data to generate custom project proposals that are specific to individual requirements.

For the owner, the outcome is a building which is more attractive to tenants with a solar PV system on the roof that reduces overall electricity costs and the carbon footprint. The metrics achieved were a \$26K saving, 47% bill reduction and a 3.5 year payback.





Electrical Contractors, Big Winners In Transition To Electric Vehicles (EV)

Most industries which have been around a long time are facing the "D" word – disruption. New technology eating up their market share. It's here that the electrical trade is unique. Not only is it a well-respected and established trade – it is on the precipice of tremendous growth as we enter the all-electric economy.

The scale of what is possible is truly beyond what we might imagine. Well, imagine no more - the transition to Electric Vehicles is here, it's happening faster than we think and the big winners will be electrical contractors.

How big I hear you ask? Huge, at least \$40 billion worth of business before the end of this decade. You probably already guessed this, but the big opportunity for electrical contractors is the charger installs.

Australia currently has more than 20 million cars registered for the roads. Experts in the field reckon we need at least two chargers for every car. Almost everywhere a car can be parked, we should expect to see an EV charger.

But even if we only had one per car, this opportunity is very significant. EV chargers alone represent a \$40 billion install opportunity for electrical contractors at a price of \$2,000 per EV charger. And the time to start pushing is now.

It's true, the current market share of new car sales being electric in Australia is tiny. In 2021 only 2% new car sales were electric. But it is the growth rate of these vehicles which is about to change everything. For the past seven years in a row, sales of electric cars have more than doubled in Australia. If this rate continues (and it is likely to actually increase as their prices drop below traditional internal combustion engines), then the majority of new cars sold will be electric by the year 2027.

Your next car or work van will probably be electric, and should certainly be electric if you want to be able to sell it on the secondhand market. This is a really important factor in the transition to Electric Vehicles. Many people will go EV simple because they don't want to get caught with a second hand car they can't sell.

Consumers love electric cars because they are faster, cleaner and quieter. But they aren't just getting cheaper to buy, they are much cheaper to run. With the cost of petrol at around \$2 a litre, electric cars are anywhere between \$3,000 and \$5,000 cheaper to run a year. But it's not just the cost of fuel, they have 90% less moving parts and require far less service and maintenance. If we add to this the revolution which is occurring with renewable energy, charging your electric car won't just be cheaper than filling it up, it will actually be free. 


What is the most rewarding part of your job?

Middy's Racing

The Far North Queensland heat and the cold, wild weather at the Bend provided challenging conditions in the recent 2022 Repco Supercars Series races...

The NTI Townsville 500 had it all

Controversial finishes, the Far North Queensland heat, untested tyre compounds and long-format racing provided some new challenges. Reid Park's hybrid street circuit layout, inclusive of big kerbs, was always going to deliver spectacular racing and it didn't disappoint. The BJR team employed several strategies over the 8-10 July weekend for the No#14 Middy's Supercar entry.

Race 19 on the Saturday saw Bryce qualify in P16. The team decided to start on the super softs compound, one of only four cars to do so. The longevity of the super softs on Reid Park was unknown as the half street, half purpose-built, 2.86km track is known for its tyre degradation ability. It literally eats them up. Bryce handled the car well and placed mid-pack throughout the entire 88 laps. The super soft tyres proved effective for the first part of the race, however around the 30 lap mark it was time to pit and change to hards. As the race length was 250kms, it was also a requirement to refuel and a minimum of two pit stops was mandatory for both races (19 and 20). Bryce did a great job and finished in P15.

Sunday was a new day and Race 20 was another 250kms. With the fatigue of the previous day setting in, the qualifying rounds proved tricky. Bryce ended up qualifying mid pack in P16 for Race 20. Given that this was the weekend's final race, there was a good chance that the Safety Car would be needed in Race 20, with predictions that there may be some argy-bargy at the start. With this in mind, BJR decided to start Bryce on the hards, as there would be no advantage to start on the super softs if the Safety Car was deployed early in the race. This decision proved to be the right choice, as there was an incident on the opening lap with contact made on Turn 3 between Scott Pye and Will Davison, which saw the need for the Safety Car to control the race. When the racing got back underway, Bryce once again was in the mix for the entire 88 laps. The race came down to the wire, with a controversial finish as Van Gisbergen and De Pasquale came to blows within the final seconds of the race. Van Gisbergen was ultimately crowned the winner, his second win for the weekend. Bryce had a consistent and positive weekend finishing in P13 and once again, the Indigenous livery gained a lot of attention.

A cold, windy and wild weekend at The Bend

Cold, windy and wild. That was the OTR SuperSprint at The Bend on 30-31 July for Round 8 of the 2022 Supercars Championship.



The weather played its part across the whole weekend which lead to Bryce having to contend with low visibility and some extremely dangerous conditions. The Bend is one of those tracks where you just never know what the conditions are going to bring. The wet weather made it even more difficult to overtake, making it vital to have a good qualifying session. Also, with the Supersprint format over the weekend, it made it even more difficult to make any adjustments and/or to change things up.

Car balance and tyre management were always going to be crucial across the three races as they were back on the softs and The Bend is the second longest circuit on the Supercars calendar, behind the Mountain.

Saturday's racing saw the No#14 Middy's Supercar eliminated after part two of the three-part knock-out quals, leaving Bryce to start Race 21 in P19. Bryce ran longish in Race 21 where he had a good battle with Kostecki, but got stuck in traffic after his pit stop and finished in 17th place.

Bryce did a great job in the qualifying session for Race 22 gaining a P9 start position. The ever changing elements and conditions led to difficulties with grip across the morning, however Fullwood still finished with a P11 starting place for Race 23. Unfortunately Race 22 saw Bryce's teammate Andre Heimgartner end up in a serious accident at the start of the race. Andre was taken to hospital but luckily had no serious injuries. His car on the other hand, required a total rebuild. The delayed restart meant it became a time-ensured race, with Bryce driving consistently and with good pace leading to a P10 finish in Race 22.

As the fog rolled in for Race 23 it made the racing conditions very difficult. Visibility was low, which meant that Bryce had to aim into the apex and hope he'd exit the corner still in the driving line. Unfortunately, this led to Bryce shooting off the road at one point in the race. Overall, he crossed the line in P17.

BCNA Pink Tradie Beanies stand out at Sandown

The Pink Tradie Beanies, worn by the BJR team, were the talking point across the Pierlite Oil Sandown SuperSprint over the 19-21 August weekend. Middy's partnered with BJR to raise awareness of our ongoing support of Breast Cancer Network Australia (BCNA). The #14 Middy's Supercar bonnet was adorned with the BCNA pink lady and the entire BJR team donned BCNA Pink Tradie beanies.

Once again it came down to car balance and tyre management strategy across the three races. As they were back on the super softs and with the 13 turns across the historic Sandown circuit - it was all about the degradation. The three-day racing weekend started



with the sun out most of the time, but there was still a heap of mud around the grounds from a down pour on Thursday night. It was mostly on the back-side of all the kerbs, and when cars went off, the grass was damp so the Supercars just aquaplaned. It could have been a lot worse with more rain.

Day one on the Friday started with a round of practice sessions, Fullwood finished in P21. Practice session 2 saw the co-drivers for Bathurst jumping behind the wheel. Dean Fiore jumped in the #14 Middy's Supercar - getting some laps in before Mt Panorama.

Saturday's racing on day two started with the quals session for Race 24, similar to Tailem Bend, this was a three part knock out. The #14 Middy's Supercar was eliminated after part two, leading Bryce to start Race 24 in P17. With Bryce finishing in P16 in Race 24, Brad Jones commented that: "I felt like we had the right strategy today, going early and running 14 longer hoping that better tyres would allow for passing but it was not the case."

Sunday's session on day three, once again started with the qualifying round for Race 25, where Bryce gained a P16 start position. With the sun shining and unfortunately mechanical issues in #14 Middy's Supercar, Fullwood finished with a P23 starting place for Race 26. These issues continued throughout Race 25 for Bryce, the thought was the #14 Middy's Supercar suffered a steering problem - leading to a pump failure, which hampered Bryce's ability throughout the 36 lap race. He crossed the line in P21.

With Race 26 still to come that afternoon, the mechanics in the BJR team worked fast to try and fix the issue. Starting in P23 was always going to be challenging, not to mention the mechanical issues. Bryce put these challenges behind him and drove very well over the 36 laps and following a good strategy he managed to cut through the field and crossed the line in P17.




