

Valley Park Farm

CUSTOM CT CABINET & MAIN SWITCH BOARD BUILD

Valley Park Farm is a locally owned business which produce free range eggs to the Victorian and New South Wales markets.

The day after boxing day 2021, a battery pallet jack at the egg packing facility caught fire. The fire quickly spread into the plant including the Main Switchboard which was destroyed.

Priority was to get mains power to site and a custom CT cabinet was needed to be sourced quickly. Secondly construction of a new permanent main switch board (MSB) was required. Requirements for the new MSB included solar and stand by generator equipment.

Shane from Dando Electrical was engaged to rewire the plant and rebuild the electrical system. Shane contacted Hank Terpstra from Middy's Industrial for his assistance in sourcing a temporary 400A CT metering MSB to power up the site. Valley Farm could then continue to operate during the rebuild phase.

Hank also assisted in sourcing a switchboard builder who was able to produce shop drawings and seek design approvals in a very short time frame. A new 1250 Amp 8 meter long custom-built switchboard was manufactured and installed in time for the scheduled production commencement date.

Valley Park Farm are very appreciative and impressed with Hank and Shane's efforts to get the switchboard to site and operational as quickly as they did.

The Dando Electrical team, comprising of 15 electricians and apprentices, put in 16-hour days 7 days a week to deliver the project ahead of schedule. Since the fire some 11 months ago the plant is now fully operational, cleaning, sorting and packing up to one million eggs per day.

Dando Electrical would like to extend their appreciation and gratitude to Middy's, particularly the efforts and support from Hank Terpstra who without his input and knowledge the Custom built MSB would not have been delivered on time.

Shane is hoping for a quieter Christmas holiday this year...

Investing In Our Industrial Future

As part of Middy's drive to offer you more, we provide our seasoned staff with the opportunity to upskill and specialise. One such program is the Industrial cadetship, which aims to provide an intermediate understanding of the principles, terminology and brand/product specific information surrounding the industrial industry.

The outcome of this course is so the cadets can confidently offer industrial electrical product selection advice to other staff and customers. We caught up with recent graduate **Belinda Blaess**, to discuss her experience with the cadetship.

How long have you been working for Middy's?

I started my Counter Sales role at Middy's Swan Hill just over three years ago.

What does that role involve?

With Middy's Swan Hill being in regional Victoria, we all help each other to get the job done for our customers. My day consists of answering customer calls, serving on the counter, packing customer orders, ordering and receipting goods and delivering goods to customers. We work together as a team everyone helps everyone.

What piqued your interest to apply for the cadetship?

I really wanted to learn more about industrial before the cadetship even came about. I already had Troy Crawford, Middy's Industrial Business Development Manager, as my mentor, so when the cadetship came up it was just perfect timing.

How was the cadetship experience (i.e. how long was it, what did it involve)?

The course took about seven months all together. We started in March and finished in September. Throughout that time, it was a mixture of some online learning days and some face-to-face. It was a great mix as it's important to help build my network by meeting other cadets and the instructors in person, but at the same time the online sessions were handy to avoid being out of my branch, especially when Swan Hill is so far away from Melbourne.

The course itself involved learning about the basics of Industrial; how to sell it, where to go and essentially who best to contact depending on what questions our customers ask. At the end of the cadetship we had to do a presentation which covered our journey, where we've come from, our sales results and what we thought of the course.



What did you achieve from doing the cadetship?

The increased customer confidence I gained resulted in my branch's July to September sales figures to increase by 29.7% compared to the same time last year. I also gained a valuable career experience when I hosted an Industrial breakfast with the help of Troy Crawford. We spoke to customers about upcoming jobs, what we can offer and the stock that Middy's can supply.

How do you apply your skills from the cadetship now and what does this mean for your branch?

I apply the skills I learnt when I'm talking to customers. I know a lot more about Industrial now, so it gives me the ability to be able to offer more products and a higher level of knowledge when helping customers. As a result we've seen an increase in sales, just because sales that we weren't previously able to service, we can now acquire as I know how to present and deliver them. We are also getting the harder questions coming through to the branch because customers have more confidence in us.

What is the most rewarding part of your job?

The customer satisfaction. I suppose at the end of the day it's all about the customers and we have some pretty awesome customers out here so it's all about meeting their needs and getting some of those harder sales. That's probably the most rewarding.

How do you see the future of industrial electrical?

I think the future of industrial electrical will always be there. As it becomes more of an automated world out there, there's going to be more and more need for it. If we can be on the front foot, knowing our products and knowing what our customers want, then I think that's where we need to be.



Rural Power Generation

TERIP TERIP HOMESTEAD POWER GENERATION PROJECT

With fluctuating power issues at Terip Terip, a small Victorian rural location within the local government area of Murrindindi, the clients approached the team from M&P Electrical in Euroa to come up with a solution. From there Michael approached Andrew McLeod from Middy's Benalla to assist. After analysing the power requirements, Troy Crawford (Middy's Industrial BDM) along with the technical team at Pramac offered the GSW45 Generator as the best solution.

As the property runs off a SWER line (Single Wire Earth Return) this unit was reconfigured in-house by Pramac engineers to supply 30kVA 2 Phase 480V to the property. This was coupled with a Pramac built Automatic Transfer Switch, so if the power fluctuated more than 10% above or 6% below it brings the generator into play. All without the need for human intervention.

This system has the capability to run power for the entire homestead including Power, Lighting, Split Systems, Floor Heating and Refrigeration. Not losing power is paramount in the last case as there are critical medicinals that must be kept at a constant precise temperature.

The install has been a great success thanks to the excellent work conducted by the M&P Electrical Team. The homestead owners are not even aware of when or how often the generator is brought into play unless they view the software log. Which also importantly lets them know the fuel consumption and when refilling is required.



We caught up with Simon Hoppe, 2022 Nick Middendorp Small Business Award winner for a chat...

Middy's: Congrats Simon on being a 2022 Middy's Small Business Award Winner (and winner of the \$10K Nick Middendorp Award). Can you tell us a bit about your business? Simon: Konekt Electrical is a family owned electrical contracting business in Albury having grown from being a sole trader over ten years ago to now being a team of 3 employing a qualified electrician and an apprentice.

In alignment with customer expectations our business has changed over the years and we have now branched into solar installations as a specialisation. Adaptability is one of the key elements in maintaining a successful business; to the changing needs of builders and home owners, and to embrace rapid improvements in technology.

We partner with a number of local builders that build bespoke homes and undertake historical restorations and expansions. We enjoy the challenge that these unique builds bring to deliver top notch outcomes. We also cover a range of electrical works for individuals, encompassing heating and cooling, fans, lights, maintenance and safety upgrades. Essentially, we aim to help people with any of their electrical needs.

We focus on the quality of what we deliver and spend the extra time to ensure that our work is completed to an exceptionally high level, even if it takes longer, it's worth it. Our staff are engaging and we make a point of being open with our clients on our ability to complete the works and the time frame of deliverables. This makes a huge difference in managing our business, reducing stress and pressure by using transparent communication.

M: How has winning a Middy's Small Business Award helped your business?

S: It has helped heaps and we are looking at splitting the funds across some different areas. We are keen to progress with additional training on solar and battery installations and home charging bases for electric vehicles so the funds will be perfect for that.

We are also looking at expanding our van fleet to enable us to work across additional sites. The funds can go to fitting out a new van with shelving and roof racks. We are also looking at setting up a new trailer for solar transportation as currently we are just using our general trailer. Setting up a new trailer tailored for solar panels and equipment transportation would vastly improve our efficiency in delivering solar projects.

Another area we are looking to invest in is IT improvements. Along with many small electrical contractors, we often find ourselves drowning in paperwork. Any remaining funds could be spent on improving our current processes to help automate our administrative operations.

M: What future plans do you have for your business?

S: Our business will continue to explore opportunities for sustainable environmental electrical installations and delivering more advanced solar and battery solutions is a key part of this. We're keen to provide advanced technologies pro-actively to our builder and home owner customers.

Enhancing the efficiency in our operations is a big part of our future plans. Operational improvements will allow us to expand to an additional apprentice and ensure succession planning across the business to provide us with more flexibility as we manage delivery across multiple jobs.

M: Why do you choose Middy's as your wholesaler of choice?

S: Middy's has been instrumental in supporting us with our expansion to solar installations. Middy's do all our solar design and provide us with competitive prices on all of the solar panels and equipment. The staff who work on our solar designs are terrific and if we ever have issues on site they have been able to provide us with an extra level of support. Our local Middy's Albury branch typically holds a large variety of stock on site and are efficient in ordering when we require unique items. 
